### WHAT IS THRIVE?

The THRIVE Initiative is designed to empower parents from the birth of their children until they reach 18 years of age. THRIVE includes four agespecific programs: *Take Root!*

(o-3 years), Sprout! (3-5 years), Grow! (5-10 years), and Branch Out! (10-18 years). Each program guides parents in learning and using parenting skills that are based on science, so they can encourage positive youth development and resiliency across their children's lifespan. Each program focuses on three areas: 1) Positive parenting practices; 2) Parent & child stress management; and 3) Child physical health promotion strategies. The THRIVE Initiative is a partnership between the Department of Defense's Office of Military Community and Family Policy, and the Clearinghouse for Military Family Readiness at Penn State.



## THE GROW! PROGRAM IS NOW AVAILABLE!



### For parents of children ages 5-8 Grow! is designed to help parents foster their child's development through the elementary school years.

We were thrilled to begin offering the Grow! program to military installations in March 2016! We are actively searching for additional installations to participate in the program.

### About the program:

Grow! parent sessions take place once a week for five weeks. Each session lasts 90-minutes and includes videos and activities.

#### How it works:

After an installation decides to participate, there will be at least two points of contact (a coordinating facilitator and a delivery facilitator). Both facilitators will complete online training to be certified as a *Grow!* facilitator. Once trained, they can begin recruiting parents to register!
